## Tennessee Child Safety Seat Law Quick Fact Sheet

process.*

**As children grow,

four steps:**

## INFANT

Rear facing infant seats in the back seat from birth to one year old and 20 pounds.

## TODDLER

Forward facing toddler seats in the back seat from age one through age three and greater than 20 lbs.

## BOOSTER

Booster seats in the back seat from age four through age eight, less than 4' 9" tall.

## SEAT BELT

Safety belts in the back seat at age nine and greater than 4' 9" tall.
